**The Age and Sex Structure of Jovellar Population:
Facts from the 2010 Census of Population and Housing**

The recorded total household population or non-institutional population of Jovellar in the 2010 Census of Population and Housing (CPH) is 16,890, a decrease of 464 persons from the 17,354 households counted in the 2000 CPH.

Of the household population in 2010, 38.0 percent were under 15 years of age or 6,421. Children below 5 years old comprised 11.2 percent of the household population in the entire municipality. Children aged 5 to 9 years old accounted for 13. percent while those aged 10 to 14 shared 13.6 percent of the total household population. In 2000, there were 7,229 children under 15 years old or 41.7 percent of the total household population.

In terms of the distribution by age and sex, there were more males than females in age groups 0-44 years in 2010 with the males comprising 51.9 percent of these age groups. Conversely, there were more females than males in the older age groups 45 years old and over. The males in these age groups made up only 47.6 percent.

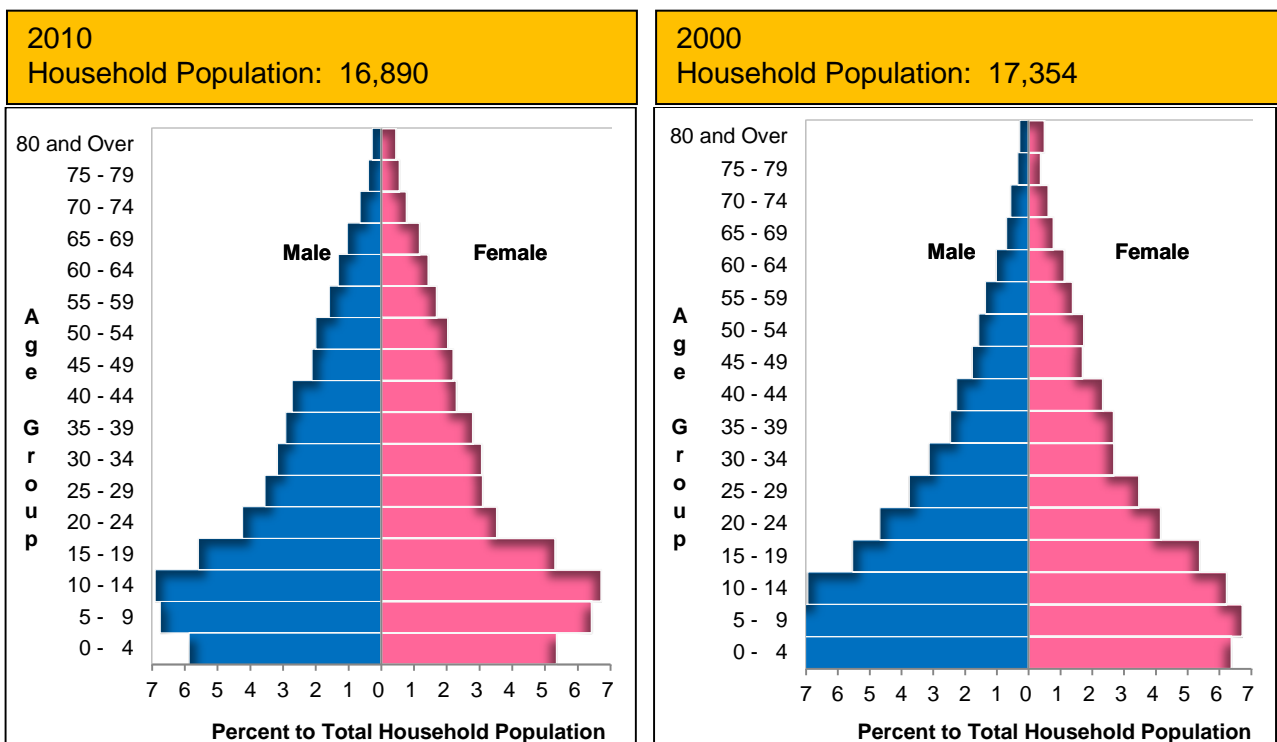


Figure 1. Age-Sex Pyramid of Household Population: Jovellar

Median age stands at 20

In 2010, the median age of Jovellar population was 20.7, which means that half of the household population was younger than 20 years. The municipality's median age for males in 2010 was 20.5, while that for females, 20.9 years.

Sex ratio at 104 males for every 100 females

Of the 16,890 household population of Jovellar, 51.0 percent were males and 48.9 percent were females. This resulted in a sex ratio of 104.3 males per 100 females, which is lower than the sex ratio in 2000 of 107.2.

In 2010, children under 15 years old had a sex ratio of 105.5 males for every 100 females, while for those aged 15 to 64 years; the ratio was 106.2. males per 100 females. For the age group 65 years old and over the sex ratio was at 79.6 males per 100 females.

Dependency ratio stands at 76

The overall dependency ratio of Jovellar was 76.4, which indicates that for every 100 working-age population (15-64 years old), there were about 67 young dependents (0-14 years old) and 9 old dependents (65 years old and over)].

School Age Population

In 2010, the school-age population (5 to 24 years old) in Jovellar comprised 45.4 percent of the 16,890 household populations. Of the population who were of school age, the males made up 51.6 percent, while the females, 48.3 percent.

Voting Age Population

The voting-age population (18 years old and over) accounted for 55.2 percent of the entire household population in the municipality. Of the voting-age population, 50.8 percent were males and 49.24 percent were females.

Senior Citizens population

Senior citizens are those aged 60 years old and over in the population. In Jovellar, they made up 8.1 percent of the 16,890 household population in 2010. Among the senior citizens, females (54.5 percent) outnumbered the males (45.5 percent).

Ageing Index

Ageing index is the proportion of persons aged 60 years and over per 100 persons under the age of 15 years. In Jovellar, ageing index was at 21.2 percent in 2010, which

translates to about 21 persons aged 60 years and over for every 100 children under 15 years old.
