The Age and Sex Structure of Daraga Population: Facts from the 2010 Census of Population and Housing

The recorded total household population or non-institutional population in the 2010 Census of Population and Housing (CPH) in Daraga is 115,562, an increase of 14,628 persons from the 100,934 households counted in the 2000 CPH.

Of the household population in 2010, 31.8 percent were under 15 years of age or 36,723. Children below 5 years old comprised 10.3 percent of the household population in the entire municipality. Children aged 5 to 9 years old accounted for 10.7 percent while those aged 10 to 14 shared 10.8 percent of the total household population. In 2000, there were 36,050 children under 15 years old or 35.7 percent of the total household population.

In terms of the distribution by age and sex, there were more males than females in age groups 0-44 years in 2010 with the males comprising 51.1 percent of these age groups. Conversely, there were more females than males in the older age groups 45 years old and over. The males in these age groups made up only 46.3 percent.

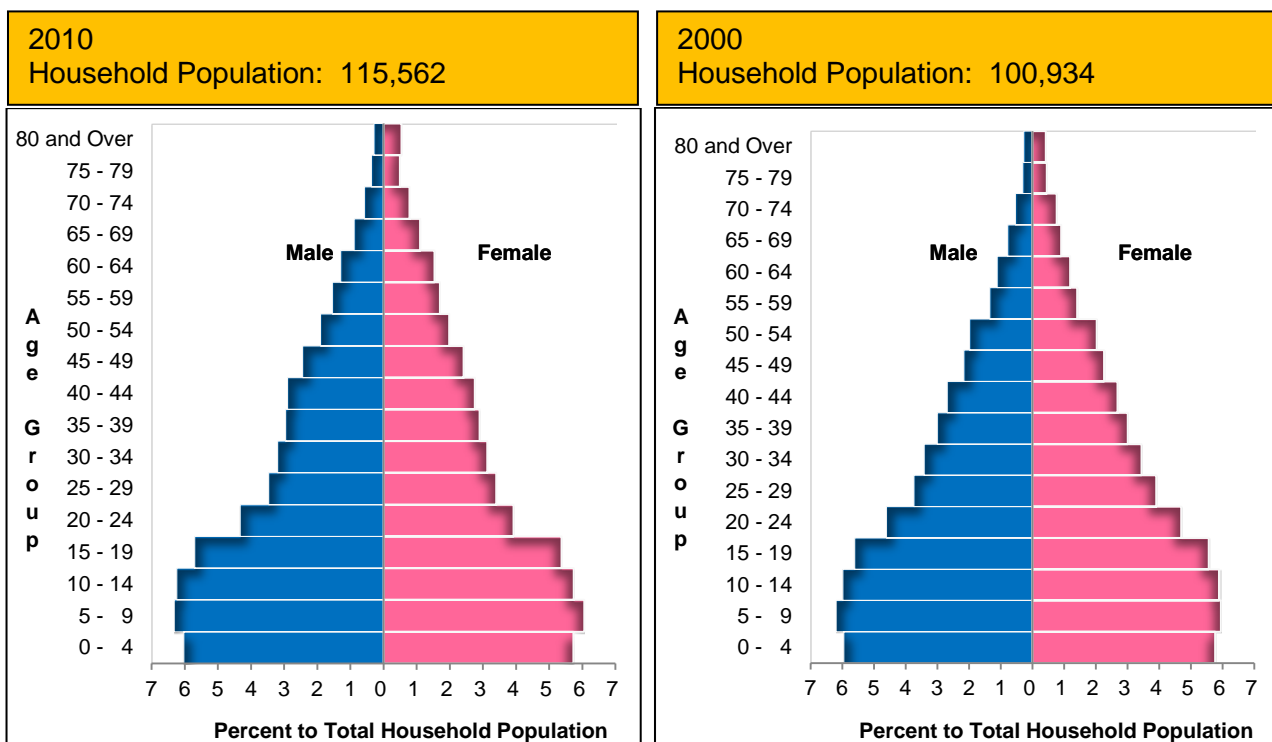


Figure 1. Age-Sex Pyramid of Household Population: Daraga

Median age stands at 24.1

In 2010, the median age of Daraga population was 24.1, which means that half of the household population was younger than 24.1 years. The municipality's median age for males in 2010 was 23.3, while that for females, 24.7 years.

Sex ratio at 100 males for every 100 females

Of the 115,562 household population of Daraga, 50.1 percent were males and 49.9 percent were females. This resulted in a sex ratio of 100.3 males per 100 females, which is lower to the sex ratio in 2000 at 98.6.

In 2010, children under 15 years old had a sex ratio of 108 males for every 100 females, while for those aged 15 to 64 years; the ratio was 100 males per 100 females. For the age group 65 years old and over the sex ratio was at 67 males per 100 females.

Dependency ratio stands at 58

The overall dependency ratio of Daraga was 58, which indicates that for every 100 working-age population (15-64 years old), there were about 50 dependents young dependents (0-14 years old) and 8 old dependents (65 years old and over)].

School Age Population

In 2010, the school-age population (5 to 24 years old) in Daraga comprised 41.6 percent of the 115,562 household populations. Of the population who were of school age, the males made up 51.1 percent, while the females, 48.9 percent.

Voting Age Population

The voting-age population (18 years old and over) accounted for 61.7 percent of the entire household population in the municipality. Of the voting-age population, 49.1 percent were males and 50.9 percent were females.

Senior Citizens population

Senior citizens are those aged 60 years old and over in the population. In Daraga, they made up 8.0 percent of the 115,562 household population in 2010. Among the senior citizens, females (57.5 percent) outnumbered the males (42.5 percent).

Ageing Index

Ageing index is the proportion of persons aged 60 years and over per 100 persons under the age of 15 years. In Daraga, ageing index was at 25.2 percent in 2010, which translates to about 25 persons aged 60 years and over for every 100 children under 15 years old.
