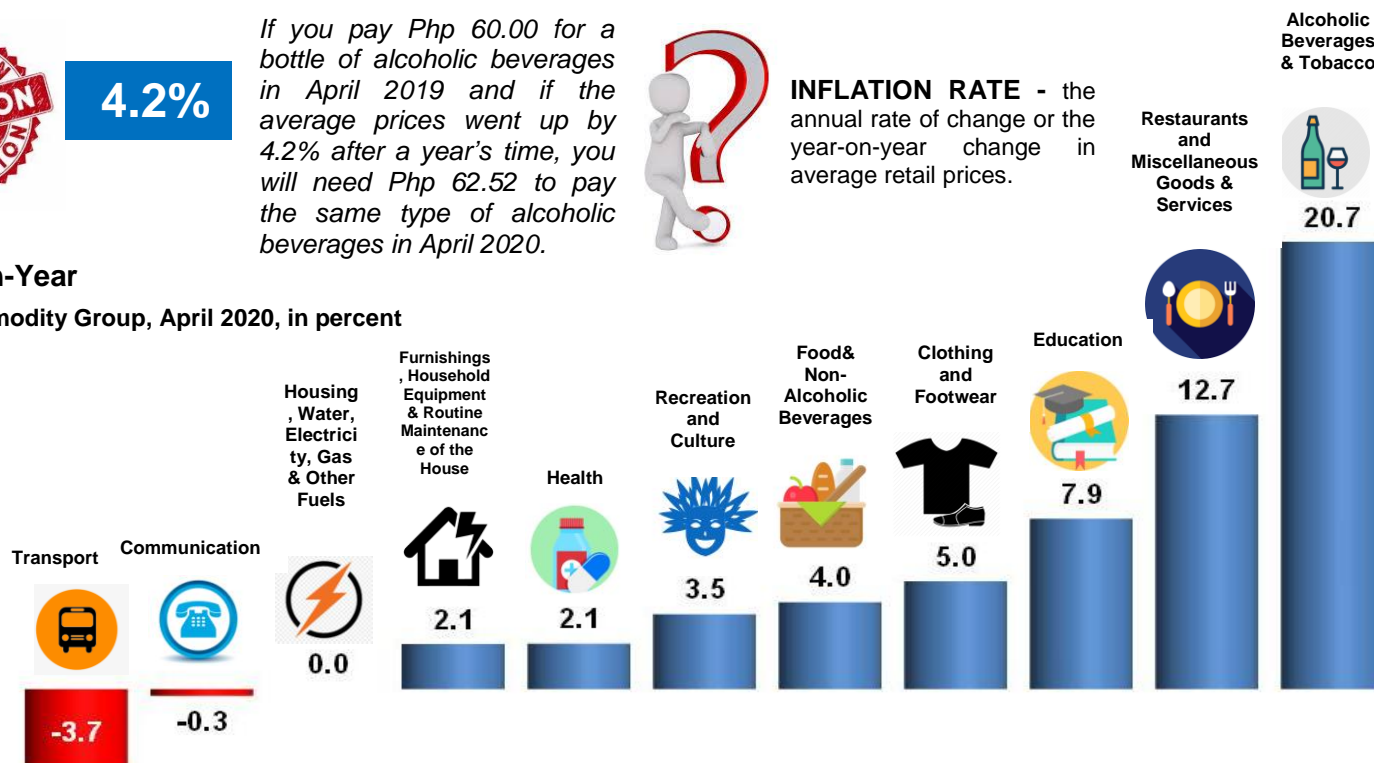
If you pay Php 60.00 for a bottle of alcoholic beverages in April 2019 and if the average prices went up by 4.2% after a year's time, you will need Php 62.52 to pay the same type of alcoholic beverages in April 2020.



INFLATION RATE - the annual rate of change or the year-on-year change in average retail prices.

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI) for April 2020 is 122.4. This means that for an average Filipino household to afford same values of goods and services in April 2019 purchased a Php 100.00 needs an additional Php 22.40 in April 2020.



MARKET BASKET - a sample of the variety of goods and services commonly consumed by an average Filipino household to represent the price behavior of all goods and services bought by consumers.

PURCHASING POWER OF THE PESO (PPP)

A peso in April 2012 worth only 82 centavos in April 2020.



CONSUMER PRICE INDEX - measure of the changes in the average price level of goods and services that most people buy for their day-to-day consumption. It is also measures the composite change in the consumer prices of various commodities over time.

BASE PERIOD - reference date at which the index is equal to 100. Base year is 2012.

PURCHASING POWER OF THE PESO (PPP) - shows how much the peso in the base period is worth in the current period.
