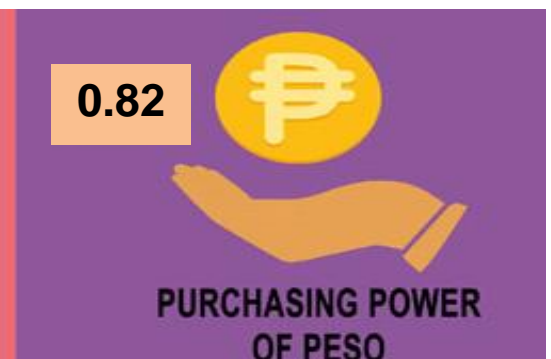
CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI) for January 2020 is 122.6. This means that for an average Filipino household to afford same values of goods and services in January 2012 purchased @ Php 100.00 needs an additional Php 22.60 in January 2020.

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI)- is a measure of the changes in the average price level of goods and services that most people buy for their day-to-day consumption. It also measures the composite change in the consumer prices of various commodities over time.

BASE PERIOD - a reference date at which the index is equal to 100. Base year is 2012.

PURCHASING POWER OF THE PESO (PPP) - shows how much the peso in the base period is worth in the current period.

INFLATION RATE - is the annual rate of change or the year-on-year change in average retail prices.



If you pay Php 50.00 for a liter of gasoline in January 2019 and if on the average prices went up by 3.8% after a year's time, you will need Php 51.90 to pay same type of a gasoline in January 2020.



A peso in December 2012 worths only 82 centavos in January 2020.
