
During the first half of the year, 1,362 babies were born and comprises the 58% of the total registered birth during the 1st semester of 2020.



Legitimacy Status

Consistent with the previous year, 65% of those babies were illegitimate and was born by the majority of women below 30 years old.

More than 50% of mothers who are at least 30 years old tend to give birth to legitimate children and as the age of the mother increases, the number of




legitimate children born also increases with wider gaps from the number of illegitimate births.



In addition, consistent with the previous years, marginally more than 50% of the babies born are male, and 99% of the babies are delivered in medical facility while only a negligible percentage were delivered in other place.


DEATHS

The actual number of deaths recorded during the 1st half of this year is 624 with 18 fetal deaths, composing the 78% of the total number of deaths registered this year.





More male's death is observed compared to female deaths consistent with the results from previous years.



TOP 5 CAUSE OF DEATH
(Underlying Cause)

1. Pneumonia
2. Essential (Primary) Hypertension
3. Hypertensive Heart Disease without Congestive Heart Failure
4. Intracerebral Hemorrhage in Hemisphere, Cortical
5. Atherosclerotic Heart Disease

Similarly, the topmost cause of deaths in Catanduanes is pneumonia. This is followed by Essential (Primary) Hypertension, which ranked 3rd last year, Hypertensive Heart disease without Congestive Heart Failure, ranked 4th last year, Intracerebral Hemorrhage in Hemisphere Cortical, 2nd place last year, and Atherosclerotic Heart Disease.

Almost half of deaths in Catanduanes were registered in Virac as Catandunganons seek medical treatment here given the concentration of the medical facility and services in this municipality. However, since Virac is populous compared to other municipalities, it also has the highest number of deaths in its residents among the municipalities followed by San Andres, also a populous municipality. On the other hand, Gigmoto has the lowest number of deaths, followed closely by Panganiban.

NATURAL INCREASE


The Natural Increase in the population for the first semester of 2020 is simply the difference between the number of Births and number of Deaths occurred in the same period. From the 1,362 babies born and 624 deaths occurred during the semester, about 738 persons were added to the population during the first half of 2020.

MARRIAGES

There were 120 marriages solemnized during the first semester of 2020 constituting the 54% of registered marriage this semester. Solemnized marriages decrease by 65% from the same period last year with 344 marriage ceremonies conducted. This may be due to current pandemic we are experiencing wherein movement and activities of the people are restricted.


More than 50%, of these recent marriages were officiated in church, a huge percentage increase from merely 35% in the same semester last year.





First Semester Solemnized Marriages



Almost half of the married couples are 25 to 29 years old consistent with the figures from previous year.



It can also be noted that most females married at younger age, with the youngest at 18 years old and oldest at 58 years old, compared to male with only few of them getting married before the age of 25 with the youngest at 21 years old and oldest at 72 years of age.



CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

Vital Statistics – statistics vital events from the civil registration such as number of births, deaths and marriages

Babies Born – number of babies that actually born in the specific year/month, it excludes those late registered births

Registered Births – number of births that were registered in the specific year/month, it includes both timely and late registered births

Legitimacy Status – status of being legitimate or illegitimate

Legitimate – babies born from married parents

Illegitimate – babies born from unmarried parents

Fetal Deaths – refers to the death of the fetus during the pregnancy

Actual Deaths – number of deaths that actually happened in the specific year/month, it excludes those late registered deaths

Registered Deaths – number of deaths that were registered in the specific year/month, it includes both timely and late registered deaths

Underlying Cause – refers to a condition/disease/injury that directly caused the death of the deceased

Natural Increase – difference between the number of births and deaths that occurred at the same period
