HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN LUBIGAN, BATO (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

Occupied housing units in Brgy. Lubigan, Bato reaches less than one hundred in 2015

There were less than one hundred occupied housing units in Brgy. Lubigan, Bato in 2015. The number of occupied housing units in the barangay reached 58 in 2015.

There are 102 households per 100 occupied housing units in Lubigan, Bato

A total of 58 occupied housing units and 59 households were recorded in 2015. This translates to a ratio of 102 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 4.83 persons per occupied housing unit.

Most of the occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anhaw

Most of the occupied housing units had roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anhaw in 2015. In Brgy. Lubigan, 81.03 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anhaw. Meanwhile, the proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum, was posted at 17.24 percent while the proportion of housing units with roofs made of tile/concrete/clay tile was registered at 1.72 percent in 2015

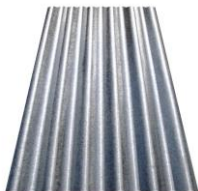

Almost half of the occupied housing units with outer walls made of bamboo/sawali/cogon/nipa in 2015

Almost half of the occupied housing units had outer walls made of bamboo/sawali/cogon/nipa in 2015. In Brgy. Lubigan, 46.55 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of bamboo/sawali/cogon/nipa. Meanwhile, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood was posted at 41.38 percent while the proportion of housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood was registered at 6.90 percent in 2015.

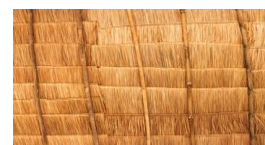
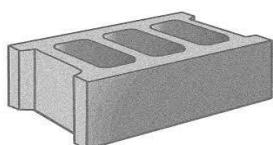

Three in every ten of the households live in housing units they own or with owner like possession of house and lot

Of the less than one hundred households in Brgy. Lubigan in 2015, 37.29 percent lived on their own housing unit and rent free lot with consent of owner. Moreover, 33.90 percent of the households lived on a housing unit they own or with owner like possession of house and lot. In addition, 28.81 percent of the total households lived in their rent free housing unit and lot with consent of the owner.

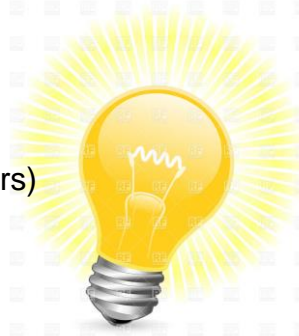

Most of the households in Brgy. Lubigan, Bato use electricity as fuel for lighting

Most (69.49%) of the households in Lubigan, Bato in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 30.51 percent of the households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015.

Shared faucet community water system is the main source of water supply for drinking in Brgy. Lubigan, Bato

Shared faucet community water system was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Brgy. Lubigan, Bato in 2015. Of the total households, more than half of the households drew water supply for drinking in shared faucet community water system while more than six households drew water supply for drinking from their own use faucet community water system. Own use tubed/piped deep well and shared tubed/piped deep well was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for four households.

Shared faucet community water system was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Brgy. Lubigan, Bato in 2015. More than half of the households used shared faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking. Own use faucet community water system ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while own use tubed/piped deep well and shared tubed/piped deep well ranked third.
