WHAT IS CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI)?

It is a measure of the changes in the average price level of goods and services that most people buy for their day-to-day consumption. It measures the composite change in the consumer prices of various commodities over time.



December 2023 - December 2024 (2012=100), in Percent

Inflation rate

The annual rate of change of the CPI expressed in percent.

Inflation Rate = $\left(\frac{\text{CPI (Present)}}{\text{CPI (Previous)}} - 1\right) \times 100$

Example:

CPI in December 2024 = 133.8 CPI in December 2023 = 131.1

Inflation Rate = $(\frac{133.8}{131.1} - 1) \times 100$ $=(1.021-1)\times 100$ $= 0.021 \times 100$

December 2024 IR = 2.1

Camarines Sur's inflation decreases by 1.8 percentage points

The inflation rate **decreased to 2.1 percent** in December 2024 from 3.9 percent in November 2024.

Market Basket

A sample of the thousands of varieties of goods purchased for consumption and services availed by the households in the country selected to represent the composite price behaviour of all goods and services purchased by consumers.

Provinces have their own market basket, hence, the number of commodities in each province varies.

Purchasing Power of Peso (PPP)

The PPP shows how much peso in the base period is worth in the current period. It is computed as the reciprocal of the CPI for the period under review multiplied by 100.



0.75

In Camarines Sur, PPP for December 2024 is P0.75

This means that a peso in 2012 is only worth 75 centavos in December, 2024.
