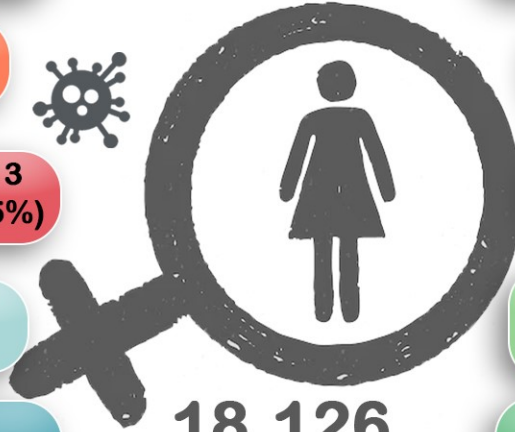


CAUSES OF FEMALE DEATHS BY AGE GROUP IN BICOL REGION, 2022
